

Frequently Asked Questions

How Many weddings or events are booked in one day?

Your date will be reserved exclusively for your wedding and reception or private event.



How long do our vendors have to set up and clean up after our wedding ceremony and reception?

Vendor set up can begin as early as 12pm the day of your event.

Ceremony chair set-up & tear down is done by your caterer or coordination staff. Mountain & Vine will ensure all tables and chairs are at the event area and ready to be set in place by your vendors. All decorations and florals must be set and taken down by you or one of your approved vendors.


Reception space set-up, clean up, and trash removal is done typically by catering staff; be sure to discuss this with your vendors. After receiving your event room floor plan, Mountain & Vine staff will make sure the needed number of tables and chairs are in the event space ready for final set up and arrangement by your catering staff and event coordinator.

How many hours of access do we get the venue?

This will depend on your rental agreement.

Wedding rentals include 12 hours of access from 12pm-12am. All wedding events must end by 11pm, but vendors can stay until 12am to clean. We do offer extended hours for an additional fees.

Private events range from 5-8 hours of rental time. With a 5-hour rental, you have 3 hours of active rental time where event guests can be on property, 1-hour of clean up, and 1-hour of set up. With an 8-hour rental, you have 5 hours of active rental time where event guests can be on property, 2-hours of clean up, and 1-hour of set up.



How much are additional hours?

Early access hours starting at 9am on the day of your wedding event are \$100 per hour. Your wedding event may end at 12am instead of 11pm for \$500.

Frequently Asked Questions

When can vendor deliveries and pickups be made?

We are happy to coordinate with you and your rental companies to accept deliveries and pick-ups within 3 days in advance of, or after your event. Nonperishable items only, please. All deliveries and pickups must be made within normal operating hours of the tasting room.

Is there a separate space for cocktail hour?

Yes, typically our scenic "lakeside lawn" is the perfect cocktail hour space for your wedding. In the event of inclement weather, you are welcome to have your cocktail hour inside our tasting room.



Where do we get ready for our wedding?

We include our 1870 chestnut timber log cabin in your wedding rental fee for the bridal party or groomsmen to get ready in. We also have a charming farmhouse on property available for separate rental through Evolve rentals.

Is there a backup plan for rain?

Wait and See, Ready to Go if needed:

The ceremony chairs are delivered to the ceremony site and can be set up by your catering staff in the arrangement designated by you or your wedding coordinator. Many couples do this because weather is unpredictable and they wish to keep their options open if the weather forecast changes.

Move Inside:

If it is raining to such a degree you wish to bring your ceremony inside, the reception room is set "California style" meaning that tables remain in place but chairs are turned to face the ceremony. Center tables may be pushed back slightly to create an aisle. Because the room is 4000 square feet, there are several options for room set up and center aisle placement. Your room set up is at your discretion or at the discretion of your wedding coordinator in conjunction with your catering staff.

Another Option:

Some couples elect to rent a clear plastic tent to cover the ceremony site or a tent to cover the bistro lit patio space between the back of the event room and the waterfall wall. Those rentals can be coordinated through one of the many event equipment rental companies serving central Virginia, or with the help of your wedding coordinator.

Is there parking available or valet parking?

We provide parking for up to 100 cars. Valet parking can be arranged through a third party vendor.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the payment process to secure our event?

For Weddings

- We require half of the venue fee to be paid up front to guarantee your date and it is nonrefundable. Your date is guaranteed only when we receive a signed contract with payment; dates remain open and available to others until then. The remaining balance is due 120 days prior to your event.

For Private Events


- We require the full venue fee to be paid up front to guarantee your date and it is nonrefundable. Your date is guaranteed only when we receive a signed contract with payment; dates remain open and available to others until then.

What forms of payment do you accept?

Personal checks, money orders, or cash are preferred. Payments processed by credit card carry an additional 3.5% fee.

Can I arrange a wine welcome for my guests?

Yes, this is a popular add-on and a beautiful addition to your day. This can be easily arranged through your caterer and the Mountain & Vine team.



Can I bring any outside alcohol?

With an ABC Banquet License, you are welcome to provide your own beer, cider or distilled spirits for your event. Alcohol of any kind must be served by an approved, licensed and insured vendor. Please also consult with your caterer regarding bar service options. All wine (sparkling and still) must be purchased through Mountain & Vine.

**Please note all beverages, alcoholic or non-alcoholic must be served in cups or glassware provided by the renter or caterer.

Where can shuttles turn around?

Shuttle buses may turn around in the parking lot at the hilltop ceremony site. The dimensions of this lot are listed below: 140 feet long and 68 feet wide. Square Footage = 9,520 ft² Square Yards = 1,057.78 yd² Acres = 0.21855 acre The entry to the lot is 25 feet wide.

They may also turn around in the parking lot beside the tasting room.

Frequently Asked Questions



Can I choose my own caterer?

You are welcome to select your own licensed and insured caterer! We require they offer “full service” staffing for event set up, service, and clean up as you will be responsible for reception set up and clean up.

**Please note that we do allow pre-packaged and cold foods at private events that do not require heating elements for service without the presence of a caterer.

Is there a required vendor list or can we choose our own?

We have a list of amazing vendors who we have worked with in the past, and we are happy to share it with you! However, we are also happy to work with any vendors of your choosing, as long as they are licensed and insured.

Are there any noise restrictions?

Nelson County does not impose noise restrictions; however, we do ask that you respect the families and farms in the area.

Do you have restrooms onsite?

We have both women’s and men’s restrooms on site. However, if your event has more than 175 guests, we strongly suggest renting an additional restroom trailer. If your guest count is over 200 we require portable restrooms.

Is your venue handicap accessible?

Many areas of our venue can be easily navigated by those with mobility restrictions. Guests that require handicap accessibility can choose to drive to the wedding ceremony site. There is a parking lot available at the hilltop. The event hall space can be accessed by wheelchair through the tasting room. Restrooms are wheelchair accessible.

Can you accommodate a live band or DJ?

Yes, we can accommodate a DJ or live band. Please note, we do not offer a separate room or dressing area for bands. However, they are welcome to relax in our Tasting Room between sets/during breaks.



Frequently Asked Questions



Are there any decor restrictions?

You may use any décor of your choosing, as long as it is not installed in such a way as to damage our walls, floors, or other surfaces.

Use of nails, tacks or staples to secure decor items is strictly prohibited. Only professional, licensed, and insured vendors are permitted to hang any additional decor/decorative lighting with prior approval from our facility coordinator.

Flower petals, dried flowers, bubbles, and sparklers are all permitted. There are no restrictions on the length of sparklers used. However, we require used sparklers to be collected in a metal bucket filled with water after use by your wedding coordinator or a responsible designated person. All used sparklers must be disposed of by the couple at the end of your event.

Throwing of confetti or glitter of any kind (including biodegradable) is not permitted.

We do not allow lighted “wish” lanterns.

Is your venue child or pet friendly?

Yes, we welcome your youngest family members and furry friends as long as they are monitored by an adult throughout your event.

Is there an onsite facilities coordinator? What services do they provide?

The facility coordinator is there to make sure the venue and the things included with the venue are ready for your event (i.e. tables and chairs). There are no additional charges for the services of your facility coordinator. The facility coordinator is onsite for the duration of your event but will not act as a wedding or day of coordinator. The facility coordinator will also help throughout the coordination process to answer any questions about the venue or venue policies.
